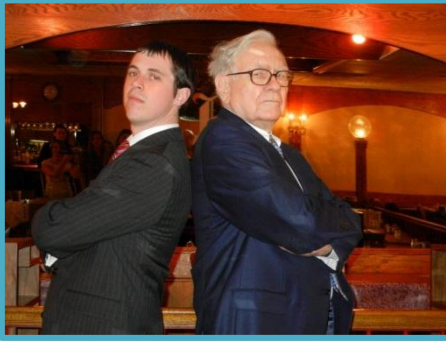


Michael Walsh
